A science camp was held at the Ghatal Yoga Satsang Vidyavidhath at the initiative of the BSS Ghatal subdivision chapter on 27 April. There were models, posters and quiz competitions. Students from schools and colleges from different parts of the subdivision participated. Mr. Shiladitya Bagh, professor of Ghatal Polytechnic College, discussed on artificial intelligence.

Residents of the Karang village and adjacent areas had been protesting for several months against the horrific pollution of the sponge iron factory set up adjacent to Karang village in Purulia district. The factory was closed for more than a month as a result of the movement. Recently, the people of the area were outraged as the factory was reopened from April 25 without any discussion with the people of the area. Then the people of the area held a meeting in the presence of members of the Purulia District chapter of the Breakthrough Science Society to build up the movement. A people's committee was formed to conduct this movement. On May 18, a citizen convention was organized at the Bhao Mela grounds of Karang village. More than 500 people from different villages came and some of them highlighted the horrors of pollution affecting their lives. They demanded that only a complete pollution free factory has to be operated. The Breakthrough Science Society spoke in the convention. He discussed the effect of pollution from the factory. BSS Purulia district chapter President and former Head Teacher Mr. Prahlad Mahato and Vice President Mr. Swadesh Priya Mahato were also present in the convention.





A science workshop was organised by the BSS, Darjeeling District Chapterat Khairbari Gramin Library, Darjeeling on 31 May, 2025. The workshop was attended by students of Class XII from Khairbari High School. Single-cell organism amoeba, onion cells, protozoa, and mammalian cells were shown under a microscope. Some basic hands-on experiments in physics - such as light dispersion, magnetism, and optics were demonstrated. The students actively participated, trying out some experiments on their own. Several questions raised by the students led to vibrant discussions. The BSS district secretary Pranoy Chandra Mondal, Vice-president Bishnu Pal, Executive Members Anwesha Pal and Mithun Sarkar conducted the workshop. At the conclusion of the workshop, the district secretary highlighted the key environmental issues in the context of the upcoming World Environment Day and called for a strong environmental movement.
